<b>Risks</b>	<b>How to minimise the Risk</b>	<b>Risk Level</b>
Covid 19	Always wear a face covering when teaching and maintain social distancing indoors	Medium
Trip Hazards (Cables and Pedals)	Keep cables tidy and out of the way as much as possible, and ensure any pedals are clearly visible	Low
Falling Equipment	Use guitar hooks that lock the guitar in place to ensure they cannot come loose. All other heavy equipment I use is to be on the floor so they can't fall.	Low
Noise and Volume Levels	I maintain a low volume in lessons as my speakers are all to a good standard of clarity. Should the volume ever need to exceed 85db then I must ensure ear plugs are used.	Low
Spilt Drinks and Liquids	Do not have drinks out by my equipment unless stored in a sealable container.	Low
Fire Hazard	I have a small fire extinguisher available at my room, and a fire blanket as well. I also must make sure no exits are blocked off by anything and point them out to any clients as a precaution.	Low
