

Statistics



- "Prior to the onset of the coronavirus pandemic, self-employment in the UK had been steadily increasing, peaking at 5.0 million people in October to December 2019 (15.3% of total employment). Since then, the numbers have fallen considerably, down to just under 4.2 million in October to December 2021 (12.9% of total employment), a level last seen in 2013. However, in January to March 2022, there was a slight increase to just over 4.2 million people in selfemployment (13.0% of total employment)." (Brown & Welsby, 2022)
