Well done Leoni, you have completed this project to an Good standard. The work submitted meets all the assessment criteria and is of a high standard.

Composition for moving image (assessor JD)

Leoni, you've worked really hard in this unit and produced some excellent work. The blog has been completed to a really good standard, and you've done some extensive research and reading around the topic which is excellent to see. The next step is to start using Harvard referencing techniques to make it more academic. The practical work is really well done and the music fits the moving images really effectively. You've used Logic Pro X proficiently to sequence the music and the music suits the mood of both clips. I agree that you could have quantised better as there are a few timing issues, but these are fairly minor and don't impact on the aesthetic quality of the music. The second clip.... On the whole there's some really good work here and you've applied yourself really well to the task – well done and I look forward to hearing more of your compositions in the future!

Electronically realised composition (assessor LB)

The composition of the track is excellent, the melody is very catchy and very suitable for pop. It is a shame it is instrumental as vocals would have taken this to another level. The balance of instruments isn't well mixed, with some overpowering melodic aspects and very centralised spectral panning, this could be due to the headphones you used to mix the track. The sounds of the instruments is the main weakness and could have been improved which would have had a significant impact on the quality of the sound. These are things to consider for your final project. The write up is detailed and extensive with clear and justified evaluation.

You successfully created an online music show over the course of 5 weeks. This is a great achievement and one you should be proud of! You successfully showcased music performed by yourself and your peers. There are multiple videos documenting the rehearsal process and plans made for the live show, complete with detailed ongoing evaluations.
