Well done Leoni, you have completed this project to an excellent standard. The work submitted meets all the assessment criteria and is of a high standard. You have shown your skills in event management throughout this project, combined with a very strong work ethic. The final performance and event would not have been such a high standard without your input and drive – well done!

Context - You have provided a strong introduction that clarifies your aims and purpose. However, you could have given some examples from the music industry. You show understanding of context throughout the performance you managed.

Research – This was good but most of the research you completed was implied. You definitely applied research directly to your project, looking at previous events (although that was only one college event – could have been more) and looking at gig posters. You can clearly see how the Shawn Mendes poster influenced your colour scheme. You could have included research into different management techniques. You must also implement research from a wider range of sources and reference carefully.

Problem Solving – You successfully demonstrated the ability to solve problems as and when required with effective and decisive means. Your job role required extensive problem solving though out and enabled you to show your skills in this area.

Planning and Production – Your planning and production skills enabled you to get this demanding project completed on time. You remained organised throughout the whole process – even when under considerable stress. You successfully organised ticketing and car parking for the event – well done!

Practical Skills – Your performance skills were excellent, and your event management skills developed to become excellent. You demonstrated a professional approach to event management role with your peers respecting your role as event manager. Your performance skills also developed tremendously, and you practiced consistently to tackle some challenging pieces!

Evaluation and Reflection – Evaluation and analysis is well written throughout the project and at the end of the project.
