What to look for	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Presentation Skills</b> – are they articulate? Do they use images, audio and video? Are they confident?</li><li>• <b>Context</b> – do they make the aim of their project clear and coherent?</li><li>• <b>Research</b> – have they mentioned how they would gather and use research to inform their ideas?</li><li>• <b>Practical Skills</b> - appropriate have they explained the processes, skills and knowledge they will apply to their project?</li><li>• <b>Evaluation and Reflection</b> – how and when do they plan to evaluate and reflect throughout your project?</li></ul>
