It is followed with many closer up shots and then and extreme close up of her unlocking the car and a medium shot of Chris getting in.

Then it is followed with the director making the camera follow where they are going so it is followed with bird eyes view and medium shots to show the highways and environment and the two cars, basically Halle following the guy with Chris.
