Summary

Then this follows with a blank scene with only siren noises and noises like hurry up quickly and the life monitor going 'teeeeee.'

This will then be followed with the scene of Abella receiving a call from hospital that travis is no more whilst she is at the apartment. You see her get very teary and break down, considering herself in the wrong and very mad with herself, she throws the teddy bears on the floor as she saw them at fault.

Narrative

It will have a Linear structure. Followed with some wide shots, close shots and high angles shots. It will be shown in a chronological order which will help things flow smoothly. this is because my aim is to let it smoothly led to one scene to the next without confusion. The settings that I will be using are 4 locations a room, café, flower shop and outside, which are based in Bradford.

Codes I will be using is:

- Symbolic: The scene where the couple will be arguing it will be edited with music running on top of the argument. The dramatic intense music will help them and make them understand the intensity and how deep the argument is and that the couple is drifting.
- Technical: Camera work that will be used mostly is wide shots to capture
 close shots to show expression and body language and wide shots to show
 the location and high angle to show how low she is feeling at the end when
 she is in tears and finds herself in fault. Lighting throughout the film will differ
 and will be all bright in the happy scenes towards the beginning but will
 turn dull when the sad scenes creep up and will be dark and dim lighting
 when she is sad.
- Audio: The audio will be in a Dial-Getic way as all conversation will be
 where the audience and actors can hear apart from the scene where they
 are arguing as it will be non-dial-Getic as the audience will hear the music
 but actors' wont and the conversations for the actor and the expressions
 will go on as usual.
- Write: These codes will be the Café sign and the Apartment she lives in.

Characters / Actors

Protagonist- Couple who have been together for 4 years. Abella has had a painful past of her dad walking out on her and her mother always drunk due to constantly being dumped by her "boyfriends".

Travis has a loving and a great childhood but has been misunderstood and been mocked at by his high school lover.

Sidekick- customer assistant serving him teddy bears

Extras- a few people walking past watching them in public

A Lady who will stare the character of Abella who will be in love with Travis and will be taking the main role it will be all on her and her actions.

A Man who will stare the main character Travis the guy who loves Abella.

A customer assistant who will serve Travis with the three teddy bears and will give him chocolates and rosses to give to Abella.
