He has a very steady control over the camera. Thanks to him also recording the bloopers our film looks good with little clips from the bloopers.

Producer, Co-director, Helper Kieran Rhodes did one respectable job in being himself, except for the part when he would have an enough and stress me out too. he did a good job in helping me around the team and being me when I felt like that is it, I have had it past the limits I cannot do no more. He was an immense help and really am thankful to him as this film has completed thanks to him. Editor Jospeh Colvill, did a great job in editing the footages, and being patient whilst we were recording the scenes.
