Meanwhile Haafsah then started check listing if we were up to date, we had then found out that we were 2 days behind with the production schedule.



Walked into Jakes lesson, had some peer assessment to do and realised our script for the narrator was a bit out of line. So, we had given it a quick edit and changed it to aim 4–8-year-olds. We changed the wording for little kids to understand so instead of words like 'eagerly' we changed them to more aged, ranged words.

After this we quickly popped down to the library and borrow up to 10 kid books to use in our shots. We came back to Bradford college and found paul and asked him if he could give us access to the greenhouse. It was till this minute we found out that the greenhouse has now turned into an office room and unable to shoot in there.
