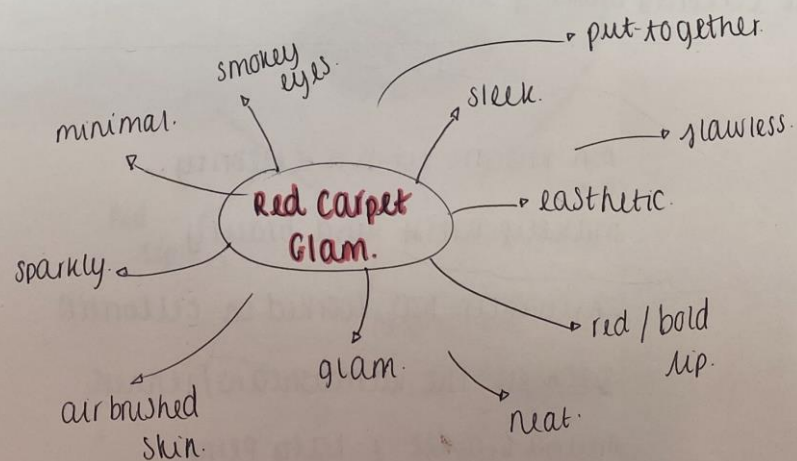

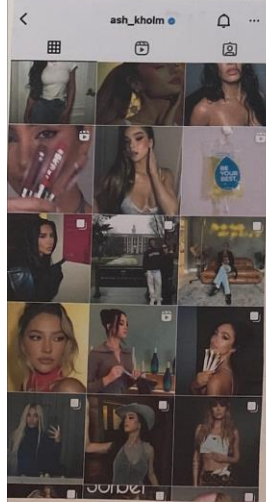
CELEB MAKUP ARTISTS:



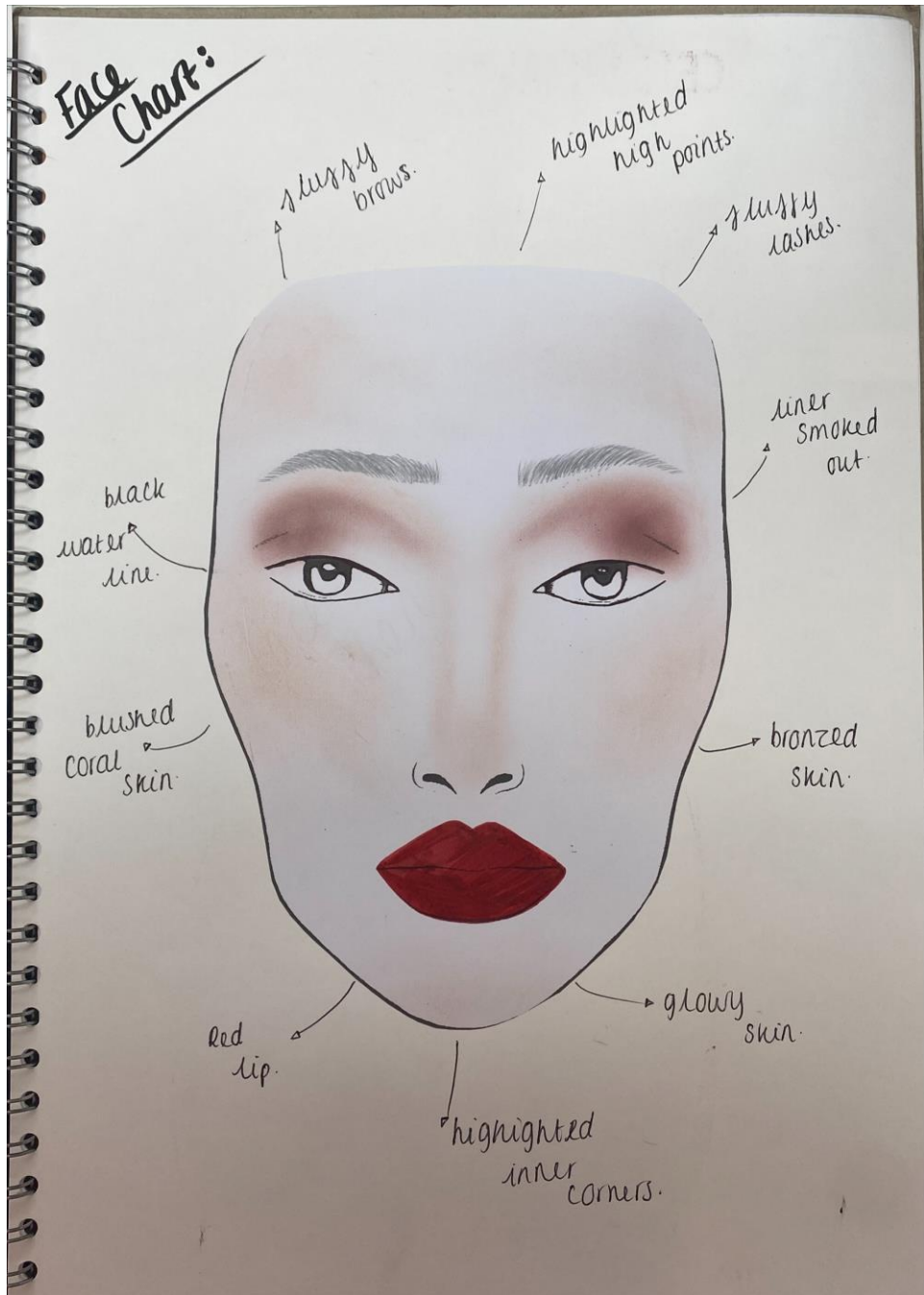
