in hand with controversy. Alot of Avant Garde art,

often comes with a social or political dimension toil over the 20th century, it started to acquire a purely artistic meaning, the period started with Gustav

Courbets reacism artworks till the final years of the abstract expressionist era in 1960's. In between the time period from 18050's to 1960's, there has been many art movements influenced the thought of time.



An Example of the term 'A vant Garde' is French painter Gustave courbet who led the realism movement in the 19th Century. Committed to painting only what he could see.

rejected academic conversation and the romantisicm of the previous generation of visual artists. (Thidesperate man) He was a predomanantly controversial artist at the time

many criticl critics also accused him of rarcissism and K"including too much of his own mkeliness" in his work. He was aread of bis time as realism was very much prowned upun years ago, whilst realism is greatly appreciated in the modern day.

HISTORY OF RUNWAYS: In the late 1800's and rearly



employed women to wear their designs around promenades surrounding racetracks, which allowed them to be noticed, emulated and protographed and picked up by the media. Around the turn of the 20th century, many high end jashion brands employed in-handouse models or "mannequins" to display their exite clientelle. These private, informal shows typically included models walking around, casually, while small groups of customers sipped tea and nibbled on canapis. However, by 1908-1910, scheduled Jashion shows or "Fashion parades" became increasingly popular events. These girst salon nosted shows rasted as long as three hours and were often repeated every day of the course of several days.



He's known for his meticulous attention to detail and the use of pabric dyed in his signature colour, red valentino is arguably responsible for some of the most memorable award show moments in frecent history including Julia Roberts accepting her oscar in 2001, in a vintage gown from his 1992 cotoure collection, marking a very memorable point in his career. valentino's love for red signature pieles came from The time he saw anyoing lady order lady wearing a , red velocet areas at the opera in parcelona. He said it was impossible to miss her and she stood out from the crowd in the legant and magestic hue. He then decided to make set but red the signature hue of the label he would set up in 1959. 

editorial, TV and film and commercial. She also mainly started off in the body art po side of the industry over 5 years ago and has worked on many sets / shoots for some of the





years without even realising the term for it. It was originally used in a religious way of showing peoples beleigs and war



Body paint originates from Agrica, Asia and Ar Australlia. To achieve this kind of body paint, they'd use materials such as dye from natural products,

Practises and plan:

For my first practise run of my body paint element, I originally wanted to have my models chest bare to have a larger canvas and freehand this kind of design over her chest however I ended up disigning a top of and chose a diggerent body paint idea to go on a diggerent part of her body. For this, I used face paint and white eyeliner for details as well as gold chunky glitter.

To match my lace top, I wanted to create some short sleeves to give the illuvion of a bodice, using lace jabric as a stencil nowever the sace design waspt too detailed therefore allowing the cream paint too lak through and just smearing. For this I tried a mix of - cream paint and normal face paint I also Practised it wouldn't have lasted well Dunder not lights and lasting 3 different show times.

For my final attempt, I decided to use th jabric as a guide and greenand the design instead, so its more detailed and can be seen from the audience. From practising this dwign, I wanted to encorpora the first design in with this one so it's more artistic and original rather than a quick design.

Garde Hair artists:




To decide what hairstyle would suit this look the bist, I researched some Damous Avant Garde hair stylists and the different techniques are that are used in the industry.

Joanne o'neill is an award winning hairdress with a prestigous salon in the heart of Northern I reland. As well as her Avant-Garde Styling, she also specialises in colouring, cutting and bridal hair. Joanne has been in the hair industry for soylars and a salon owner 22 years she has been a finalist three times for Avant barde hairdresser of the year at the british hairdressing magazine Awards. she is the regular face on stage, educating and exiting hair dressers across the uk and ireland and has been featured on BBC and ITV for ner strunning work.

knis studied nair in school at london and went on to create ombre since starting ombre, kris sorbie has became a world renowned artist and educator and grobal artistic director for redker some source of pride kris has been gratured or

is head stylist on NV+LA gashion week, guest splaker on vogue and a judge on both Loreal and Belgium bair stylist awards.

For my final body art practise, I decided to practise a mas mosaic disign over the shoulders to mimic the illusion of small sheeves to match the top. I used a snazaroo & face paint to create this disign As much as I enjoyed the final rook of this disign. I fell use it wasn't fitting for my valentino theme and wasn't the fiminine fell I was had in mind mosaic was originally used from with stones and Seashells made by ancient oreek artists.



After practising the mosaic design, I decided to combine the previous body art designs I practised and implemented the big leaves onto the smaller glowers and stems I used a mix of black and white snararoo paints and black chunky glitter for a texture ulement. I much preferred the valentino All of this to the first design and feel unke it will match the lace on the bra much better.

on the day of the jashion show, I will againstry drag the body art surther down and include longer and bigger provers so its more eye catching to the audience.

for my first practise of hair, I experimented H with heated bendys to achieve a brown out, agro textured hausstyle nowever the A finished look wasn't what I was after. I I used a mix of smaller sizes to create the 2 to most volume possible with plenty of hairspray and back combing with hair, I Daiso thought anot about what will be pist to sit my readpiece on top of securily. Kayter experimenting with the bendys, I A decided to practise a hair style I practised previously for a diggerent -makene look, but i two straight down. I decided to do a braided technique I as its something im confident in doing c and it fit my theme perfectley. After practising on real hair, I know to E.use either a gel or hairspray to get it as reat as possible for the day. I've also reacised that once the head piece is on, the ends of the braids rooked a rittle bare so

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for both the assessment and fashion show, I'll be adoling some small rose petals in the in each elastic band to avoid it looking too simple and out of place with everything else combined.

Outrit Plan:

Original For my outpit, I wanted to keep it as glamourous plan idea? as possible while also keeping it similair to valentino's signature techniques. To achieve this finish, I used a lot of pearls, crystal finish inimestones and sick. In my first design plan, I was planning on creating a shorter skirt with a painted corset however, I decided to switch it up.

For this design I wild planned on using body painting shills to create the illusion of a structured cosset, nowever for the fashion show, it wouldn't now held up for long without a lot of touchups. shirt with lay ered mesh but decided it was too simple for a live cuidience, soigt so I shirt decided on a shirt with a train for my model to pull behind her my idea for silk gloves with added shup along the tops has stayed the same.

for my final layer of fabric on the dress, I arcided to get black pears so it isn't too blacked out and has element of sparkle overall, my disign hasn't changed chamatically, however my final disign accomodates better to an audience and gits the valentino elegant theme.

For my ginal outgit design, I decided to work around a bra rather than draw a corset on. I purchased a brace bra and created a tassie effect across the underneath with white pearls and rhinestones. I finished this op with a guitter spray over on the bra Cups. I did also want to cover the strap by attaching either reathers or slupp, however the material of the straps didn't allow me to stick

anything securely on without falling off, which is something in help in mind for future outfit plans.

For my shirt, I purchased a shirt and attatched shorts underreath for structure and proceeded to start filling it out with 3 layers of mesh including a pear sheet of mesh to finish. I also made a bow out of cut offs to be attached to the back of the waist to match the gront.

for accessories, I opted for body paint on the shoulders to create the illusion of a bodice with sheves rather than making them. To finish, I stuck black flugg around the top of a pair of silk gloves.

making different length pearstassie ranging from small to long back to short. I was inspired to add pears as valentino took a lot of inspiration from boild glamarand the expensive feel it adds to both the model and whole finished look.

Following on from creating a bord glamar inspired LOOK, I wanted to fill up the empty space of my models arms by adding silk gloves. I wanted to encorporate silk atleast once to match the theme of pearls of lace. I finished this by adding full from a black boa and created a pearl ring and bracelete by sticking them directly onto the glove.
