

### HOW TO WRITE A CV

### What information should I include on my CV?

CVs should never be completely formulaic, but there are a few things they should always contain:

### · I. Personal details:

• It may sound obvious, but you'd be surprised how many people forget to include their name, email, contact phone number and address. To avoid any awkward moments, make sure these are clearly presented at the top of your CV. 'Curriculum Vitae' is an unnecessary title – your name is not.

#### 2. Personal statement

• As it's the first thing that's shown on your CV, a <u>personal statement</u> is an essential part of standing out from the crowd. It explains who you are, what you're offering, and what you're looking for. Aim to prove why you're suitable in one short and succinct paragraph.

### • 3. Work experience:

• This section should include all of your relevant work experience, listed with the most recent first. Include your job title, the name of the organisation, time in post, and your key responsibilities.

### 4. Achievements:

• This is your chance to show *how* your previous experience has given you the skills needed to make you a suitable candidate. List all of your relevant skills and achievements (backing them up with examples), and make it clear how you would apply these to the new role.

### 5. Education:

• Your educational experience and achievements should be listed here, along with dates, the type of qualification and/or the grade you achieved – although the specific parts of education that you include in your CV will depend on your individual situation. For example, if you have more educational achievements than work experience, placing an emphasis on this section is a good idea.

### • 6. Hobbies and interests:

• You don't always need to <u>include hobbies and interests in your CV</u>, but mentioning relevant ones could back up your skills and help you to stand out from the crowd – not to mention give you something to talk about at an interview. Just don't say you enjoy <u>socialising with friends</u> just for the sake of including something. If it's not going to add value, leave it out.

• Any extra information, such as reasons for a <u>career change</u> or reasons for <u>gaps in career history</u> should also be included as required.

I got in there and set up my station with my kit ready to go and dive straight in to doing a soft copper look on the bride's mother. It was very nervousAs obviously this is someone's day and you do not want to do anything to ruin it. Doing the make-up film confidence and afterwards I was very proud of how to look came out. Having my tutor there to guide me through the process made it a lot easier and less nerve racking. Afterwards my tutor said she was very proud of me for how it turned out and said it was really good this fills me with much confidence as knowing that I can impact on someone's life like that.

• For the bridal make up I created a soft bronzy I look with a flawless Dewey skin that was also Matt to make the client happy. I did this by doing a soft skin but then powdering areas, so it wasn't as Julie for the client. For the eyes I went in with ground in deep coppers and the black liner with eyeshadow to give me definition it's needed. When working on Mature skin it's well to prep the skin first with a good moisturiser and then make sure you apply the make up, so it looks more appropriate for the client as you don't always want to do something too heavy.













### Bridal research
