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Areas for Development:

Moving forward towards FMP, the best thing for you to do is find a way that works for you to creatively research, reflect and evaluate your progress. Recording your reflections is working well for you. I recommend using software like chat GPT or Grammarly to help writing your research. Just remember that if you use any AI software you must reference it and ensure that it is your own work (the software will just do the writing for you) See below for some ideas and targets towards this final project.

Targets:

- Research: Try to be as creative as possible, use images, videos even sound clips to back up and evidence your understanding.
- Research: Use the scrapbook prompts (2/3 of them) to really push yourself in evidencing your independent skills to research the inspiration behind the Level 3 Extended students' creation.
- Research: Be sure to include a section about your production role. Talk about the roles and responsibilities you are faced with moving forward.
- Planning and Production: document and upload as much as you can. Videos, images, notes taken in class. Handouts, tutor obs, peer obs, minutes of meetings etc... Anything you can think of that shows your involvement in the production process.
- Reflections: Your reflections are getting stronger. Remember to set yourself some weekly targets. I am happy to support you in this on Monday afternoons.
- Reflections: Please remember to write a small section called "How I have used my research", this will evidence you using your research to develop throughout the process. It is vital for the FMP scrapbook.
- Evaluation: When we reach the end, be critical but useful in your words. Avoid speaking too harshly or too positively regarding the process. If there were difficulties share them, but tell me "Why" they were difficult. Be sure to put forward strategies for how you will improve next year or in the far future
- Viva: Please try to add more detail to your viva answers. Ask your peers to read them and see if you're missing elements, they can remind you of.
