Well done Tyrell, you have completed this project to a Satisfactory standard. The work submitted meets all the assessment criteria and is of a satisfactory standard.

Composition for moving image (assessor LB)

You have successfully uploaded your movie to YouTube and embedded it in Digital space. The track you have created is very effective in the compositional aspects in relation to the visual components. The tempo, mood and feel of the track, are perfectly suited to the slow pace of the timelapse, this is a really successful composition and demonstrates your ability to create music to suit the visual and emotional mood of a film. The evaluation is good but more research would have helped you to improve your understanding of film music.

Electronically realised composition (assessor LB)

The evaluation video is really helpful in explaining your process, the background noise doesn't help but it works well to explain your process. However, you have not uploaded a final track submission to you Digitalspace.

Songwriting (assessor NS)

You worked at a good level practically to plan, prepare, write and perform a piece on the piano and with rapping and really enjoyed some of your ideas. You could have been more focused to structure and finish these ideas with a final demo. You responded well to verbal feedback and improved greatly with rhythmic control. You have shown development as a pianist throughout the course so far. Your portfolio submission lacks detailed context, research and evaluation. You have not included a song analysis or talked about the songwriting techniques and musical details of your song. You have completed a very brief introduction and there is no final evaluation. You successfully wrote and performed an original song in which you only had 4 weeks to prepare for. This is a good achievement and one you should be proud of! I look forward to hearing the recording of your song in the next project.
