What will I need for this project?

Research.

While researching different films, I watched a production of Grease at my old secondary school. I need to be able to write a compelling script which is also comedic in places. I think this is the best way to write it because if not I think it would be too serious and less enjoyable to watch.

I need to be used to working with cameras so I get the right angles and others. I also need to get comfortable with image stabilization or with a tripod therefore the shot isn't shaky which would make the film seem less professional.

I will be editing with Adobe Premier Pro which I need to get used to using so I can maximize my use of the software and take advantage of its features so I can make my film the best it can be.

Context.

I would place the film in the Romance genre as it is about 2 unlikely people meet each other. According to my secondary research Romance/RomComs is most watched by 40-50 year olds. Although, my film will be more modern therefore I think it will be viewed by more 18-30 year olds aswell.
