# THE FILM

The film is going to follow the final days of a television star called Dexter Manning. Dexter has been in show business his whole life, being forced into when he was younger by his mother. This has obviously had a pretty rough effect on him and he is known to have many scandals around him including abuse, drugs, etc. The film shows how his final day of filming went before taking his own life.

I want the film to be seen as a warning of how the lives you see on television and social media are not perfect, and can actually be quite horrifying.

I think a lot of my research will be secondary research as I won't be able to get in touch with a lot of people in the public eye who may be feeling this.

- Making sure to have a risk assessment on everywhere where I may film.
- Being observant when around the equipment, ensuring everything is handled correctly.
- Making sure everyone on set understands the risk assessments.

# PLANNING

I do not have a plan just yet on how everything will work out, I want to get the script completed and work out when I will be able to book certain things for. # PROMOTION

However, I do think there is parts of the image which are quite low quality, such as the cut out of my head, so the newer version will be much higher quality.
