Recording (assessor EH)

Overall	You need to do more research throughout your projects and integrate them into the process so that you can talk about them. There's also a lack of evidencing, you do demonstrate that you understand what's happening but you could go much further in demonstrating how much you know.
Research	You demonstrate that you did some research by practicing the recording but you needed to go further here, we discussed microphones and polar patterns in class and you did some research about microphones yourself – this could have been included.
Context	You show some good planning on getting the song ready to be recorded and do a little bit of evaluation of the process but don't really speak about what you did to get ready to record it, what songs you perhaps listened to or what you researched when you were getting ready for the recording.
Practical Skills	You talk about what you did in the studio and give some basic reasons for the choices you made but you really needed to go further here and integrate some research into your reasoning.
Evaluation	A very basic evaluation at the end Ethan you need to talk about strengths and weaknesses and how you feel the project went overall, you don't really discuss any problems you had with recording or how you felt it went in the grand scheme of things.

Mixing (assessor LB)

Ethan, you have demonstrated a good approach the recording project. The practical was completed well with lots of different practice mixes and a good final project recorded. There were some issues, but these were documented through the evaluations, which were detailed and analysed the strengths and areas of improvement necessary to improve for the next project. Some good useful research here, there could have been more to provide more depth and you could have incorporated the ideas and techniques in to your mix, but overall a good effort to find relevant mixing research.
