

Podcast Production Proposal



A proposal is a document that presents the idea of your podcast before writing the script. Proposals are often written in present tense, in a narrative-like prose, and highlight the most important information about your podcast, including name, theme, content and potential guests. Proposals are often used in the initial stages of idea generation and will be used to support a pitch and sell your podcast idea to producers or production members.

Another issue that I have got with this game is the MyFaction mode where you try to unlock different cards which are variations of different wrestlers. I feel that the mode is a cash grab on 2K's part and is unnecessary for there are some cards that you can use that are exclusive to MyFaction.

Also, WWE 2k24 hasn't got a lot of content to play with which could lead players to get bored easily.

Another problem that I have got with WWE 2K24 is the appearance of Brock Lesnar in Showcase mode which where you play real life WWE matches that have happened. The problem that I have got when it comes to having Brock Lesnar in the game is that Brock Lesnar is only playable in Showcase, and you can't use him for matches. Now I get 2K what not want to include Brock Lesnar as an official playable character due to the allegations surrounding him however, I feel that it was an unwise decision on 2k's part to include him for a small bit, if he is not an official playable character.
