


Ahmed's Presentation For His Final Major Project

Also I would like to interview the **students union officer (Amer Zeman)** about how the election process works.


Making a video about the student's election will appeal to the audience because it is happening now and it is there for students to have a clear idea on who they want to elect.

Realistically, I might not be able to interview everyone but here are some people that I could possibly interview.




