Following on from the presentation on photographic joiners you are now asked to start work producing your own 'Hockney' joiner.

Tasks

- Find **examples** of joiners made by other photographer artists for influence
- Create a **mood board** of these, with annotations, in your sketchbook
- Go out on a **photo-shoot** to generate the imagery needed for your first joiner. Keep it simple to start with shooting 12-15 separate overlapping images.
- **Download** the images and make sure you back up the work
- Create hard copy prints using Photoshop (Contact Sheet II)
- Create a joiner to fit an A3 size piece of card
- Consider how you may want to develop this work further after your initial tests and experiments
