

Image Weaving

You are asked to follow the YouTube tutorial <https://youtu.be/nOxna-O6gU0> to create your own interpretation of the technique.

1. Please complete 2 image weaves using magazines, photographs, cereal cartons, own drawings Preferably of portraits, however one portrait and one non-portrait image will work well too.

Be creative with what you have especially if you don't have access to a printer. You could use 1 image from a magazine and some blank paper or newspaper. If you are interested in textiles you could use fabric and imagery to complete this task.

2. Stick your finished work in your sketchbook and annotate. You may also want to photograph what you have done, step by step to document your process.
3. Research either a photo/image weaving artist (Jason Chen, David Samuel Stern are 2 popular ones) or create a page of research on the technique itself looking at multiple artists. Don't forget to annotate your work and consider transcribing the artists researched.
