## **Image Weaving**

You are asked to follow the YouTube tutorial <u>https://youtu.be/nOxna-O6gU0</u> to create your own interpretation of the technique.

1. Please complete 2 image weaves using magazines, photographs, cereal cartons, own drawings Preferably of portraits, however one portrait and one non-portrait image will work well too.

Be creative with what you have especially if you don't have access to a printer. You could use 1 image from a magazine and some blank paper or newspaper. If you are interested in textiles you could use fabric and imagery to complete this task.

- 2. Stick your finished work in your sketchbook and annotate. You may also want to photograph what you have done, step by step to document your process.
- Research either a photo/image weaving artist (Jason Chen, David Samuel Stern are 2 popular ones) or create a page of research on the technique itself looking at multiple artists. Don't forget to annotate your work and consider transcribing the artists researched.
