The RSC serves as our employer sponsor for the Ambition Hub project, while our Student Ambassador Program offers further training and representation for learners. Regular feedback from both the Alhambra and RSC enhances the learning experience, complemented by workshops on resilience and confidence. Additionally, students gain real-world experience through backstage shadowing roles in productions like "Matilda," and they have access to reduced and free tickets for RSC performances, allowing them to engage with high-quality theatre and inspire their artistic pursuits.
