How to analyse a song

Listen Actively:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pay close attention to the music and lyrics.
Identify Elements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Note the melody, harmony, rhythm, and lyrics.
Structure:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recognize song sections like intro, verse, chorus, and bridge.
Instrumentation:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• List the instruments and notice how they work together.
Dynamic and Texture:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Observe changes in volume and the song's overall texture.
Tempo and Time:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Determine the speed and time signature.
Harmony:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Identify chord progressions and their emotional impact.
Vocals:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Evaluate the singer's technique and emotional expression.
Context:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Consider the genre, time period, and cultural influences.
Personal Response:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reflect on your feelings and preferences.
Comparison:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Compare the song to others in the genre or by the same artist.
Research:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Look up information about the song, artist, and influences if interested.
